In accordance with Item 1599-2040 of Section 2B of Chapter 41 of the Acts of 2019, the Office of the Comptroller is submitting the attached reports on prior year deficiencies to the House and Senate Committees on Ways and Means.

The attached [Paid Prior Year Deficiency Report](#) contain information regarding payment of prior year deficiencies through chargebacks to FY2020 funds.

Through the second quarter of FY2020, as detailed in the attached report, a total of \$951,398.40 was spent in prior year deficiencies for 27 departments. Of that, \$880,306.62 was incurred in accounts that had sufficient funds and \$71,091.78 was from accounts that had insufficient funds.
